

COOKIE POLICY

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the website. The information below explains the cookies we use and why:

Session cookies - these expire when you close your browser and do not remain on your computer.

Persistent cookies - these are stored in the longer term on your computer. They are normally used to make sure the site remembers your preferences.

This website uses cookies in order to make it easier to use and to support the provision of relevant information and functionality to you. Cookies also provide us with information about how this website is used so we can keep it as up to date, relevant and error free as possible. Further information about the types of cookies in use on this website is set out below.

By using this website you agree to the use of cookies. Please note that certain cookies may be set the moment you start visiting this website. These will be session cookies on your first visit to this website. If you continue to use or revisit this website then persistent cookies of the types described below will be served. You can choose to manage the cookies we use on this website through your browser settings at any time.

They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services. Analytical or performance cookies. These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

Functionality cookies. These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

Targeting cookies. These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

Cookie Title Cookie Name	Purpose
salt, surfer, visit	These cookies allow the website to identify distinct visitors to store items added to a basket or other form mechanism within a session.
hasConsent	The presence of this cookie prevents the Cookie banner from showing again after you have registered your agreement to its terms.
utma, utmb, utmc, utmz, utmv	These cookies enable the function of Google Analytics. This helps us collect and analyse visitor information such as browser usage, new visitor numbers, response to marketing activity and shopping times. That information helps us to improve the website and your shopping experience, and to make our marketing campaigns relevant.

Please note that some third parties may also use cookies, over which we have no control (such as Google) and other third parties, for example, advertising networks and providers of external services like web traffic analysis services. These third-party cookies are likely to be analytical cookies or performance cookies or targeting cookies.
